

2018 GLOBAL KOREA SCHOLARSHIP FOR AFRICAN AND LATIN AMERICAN UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

Hosted by Dongseo University

Dongseo University (DSU) has been selected as a host institution of the ‘2018 GKS (Global Korea Scholarship) for African and Latin American Undergraduate Students’. We invite outstanding undergraduate students from Latin America to apply for this training program designed to provide in-depth academic training and invaluable experience in Korea. The program seeks to nurture future leaders who will contribute to the development of global society and to friendship between Korea and their home country.

1. Dongseo University

Dongseo University is a private university founded in 1992. It has 3 colleges, 14 academic divisions, and 57 majors. The academic community comprises 11,000 full-time students, including roughly 1,000 international students from roughly 70 countries worldwide. DSU is specialized in Film & Imagery, Design, Digital Contents, Information Technology, International Studies, and Korean language teaching for foreigners. DSU is a highly globalized university that runs cooperative programs with 214 partner universities in 38 countries. It also has overseas campuses in the U.S. and China.

4. Eligibility

- a. Be a citizen of a Latin American country
- b. Be enrolled as an undergraduate student in the second to fourth year at a university/college located in a Latin American country
- c. Be fluent in English (TOEFL 530, IELTS 5.5 or equivalent level)
- d. Currently study in an academic field such as Computer Engineering, Game Engineering or Digital Design
- e. Be mentally and physically healthy
- f. Have the ability and willingness to adapt to Korean culture and life in Korea

- b. How to Apply
 - ① Choose one of the institutions listed according to your major. You are ineligible to apply to more than one university. Multiple applications will be excluded during the final selection process.
 - ② Submit all required documents to the application office of the chosen institution.
 - ③ If you pass the document screening process, you will be invited for an interview. Interviews will be conducted by either Skype or phone.
 - ④ The chosen institution will nominate students to NIIED, which will make the final decisions and announce the successful applicants for each university.
- c. Application Deadline: **April 13**
✘ Email application is available but the original document must be submitted after the final selection process

d. Required Documents

- ① Completed application form
- ② Copy of your passport's information page
- ③ Proof of enrollment at your current university/college
- ④ Original sealed transcript from your current university
- ⑤ Self-introduction and research plan
- ⑥ Letter of recommendation from an academic source

※ Additional documents may be required for the screening process

6. Benefits and Responsibilities

- a. Round trip air ticket, room and board for the duration of the program, and traveler's insurance are provided.
- b. Participants are responsible for transportation in their home country, visa fees, etc.

7. Program at DSU

During the five weeks of the program, students will acquire knowledge related to their major, especially in the areas of Raspberry Pi & IoT, VR, Computer Vision, AI and Digital Forensic. Through team projects, students will gain practical experience and determine their own goals for the final project presentation. Apart from the abovementioned major studies, students will also study basic Korean language and participate in various cultural activities, city tours and field trips.
