

Official Notification from International College  
(*Synchronous distance learning*)

August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020

1. Basic regulation:

- All courses begin offline from September 1<sup>st</sup> hence the students in Korea or students who can come to Korea have to be ready for the upcoming semester.

2. Online classes

- Only for the students who **CAN NOT** enter into Korea because of an inevitable reason such as *country border closure, flight bans or travel restrictions caused by COVID-19*, DSU will give the opportunity to take real-time online classes (*Synchronous distance learning*) using ZOOM application
- In case of *synchronous distance learning*, the regular offline classes will be streamed through ZOOM and the attendance will be checked.
- Students who attend *synchronous distance learning* should stay at home on the desk and have to keep their face on the screen during the class. Meanwhile, professors will evaluate participants' attitude for grading.
- Using PC or laptop computer is highly recommended.
