

Information for Change of Major

Qualifications

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students who are entering their sophomore or junior year. 2. Cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher.
<p><i>Students who are not eligible for application</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <i>Students who have received a special admission to the university</i> 2. <i>Students who are on a leave of absence</i> 3. <i>Transfer students (transfer students may apply in the second semester of their junior year).</i>

Application Period: During winter vacation (TBD / in January)

※ Students may change their major only once: either before entering the first semester of sophomore year or before entering the first semester of junior year

Approval Criteria

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students who have completed the career guidance program 2. Students who have passed an interview given by the department of their desired major and the department of their current major 3. If the number of students to be admitted exceeds the designated number, students shall be selected according to the order of merit. (30% of entrance quota of the corresponding year)

Notice

1. The student shall be disqualified if he/she does not submit his/her student ID or Alien card upon applying for completion of the career guidance program
